



Notice of Race

THE Olympic regatta I. Ranking regatta for the 470, Finn and Pirat classes.

2022. July 14-16.

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024.
- 1.2. The prescriptions of the HYA for 2023 will apply.
- 1.3. Appendix „P” applies.
- 1.4. Appendix „T” applies.
- 1.5. If there is a conflict between languages, the english text will take precedence.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the 470, Finn, Pirat.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the form on VIHAR (<https://vihar.hunsail.hu/>) and sending it together with the required fee. Foreign competitors may enter in the race office during the registration period.
- 2.3. Late entries may be approved upon the approval of the Organising authority.

3. FEES

- 3.1. Entry fee is HUF 22.000 /person for Hungarina Sailing Association members, and HUF 30.000 for non-members.

4. SCHEDULE

Date	Time	
July 13	16.00-20.00	Registration
July 14	8.30	Opening ceremony and skippers meeting
July 14-16	10.00	Warning signal of the first race

- 4.1. 9 races are scheduled for the regatta.
- 4.2. There will be a skippers meeting 90 minutes before the first scheduled warning signal each day at the venue.
- 4.3. There can be maximum 4 races per day.



4.4. On 16th July, no warning signal will be made after 15:00 for all classes in the Olympic regatta II.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

SI's will be available upon registration, on the notice board and on the website of the club www.thesail.hu together with the facebook site of the event.

6. VENUE

6.1. Venue is located at Tihanyi Hajós Egylet marina, 8237, Tihany, Kenderföld utca 19.

6.2. Location of the courses will be at the eastern or the western side of Tihany peninsula. The Race committee will signal which area will be used upon leaving the shore.

7. SCORING

7.1. The regatta is valid after one race.

7.2. When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of the races scores.

7.3. When from 4 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her races scores excluding her worst score

7.4. When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her races scores excluding her 2 worst scores.

8. SUPPORT BOATS

8.1. Race committee boats will be marked with a white RC flag.

8.2. Jury boats will be marked with a white Jury flag.

8.3. Support boats should be registered upon registration.

8.4. Support boats are advised to carry a VHF radio onboard. The channel for the regatta will be written in the sailing instructions.

9. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

10. MEDIA RIGHTS

By entering to the event, all competitors give the right to the organising authority to produce and use any kind of audio or video record of them. That includes records of a drone. Any actions of the drone can be no ground of redress.

11. PRIZES

Prizes will be given to top 3 boats of the classes and age groups if minimum 6 competitors are registered.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY



Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with a third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 5.000.000 HUF per incident or the equivalent.
