





## **Notice of Race**

# **Asso Hungarian Open 2025**

2025.09.18 - 21.

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1. Racing will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The Equipment Rules of Sailing applies.
- 1.3. The Race regulations and the advertising code of the Hungarian Yachting Association applies.
- 1.4. If there is a conflict between languages, the Hungarian text applies.
- 1.5. In all the rules:
  - 1.5.1. The notation [NP] in a rule means, that no boat can protest for a breach of the rule.

## 2. Eligibility and entry

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the ASSO99 class .
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter sending their sail number and list of crew tot he following email address: andi.rutai@thesail.hu and paying the entry fee.
- 2.3. Entry fee should be transferred by 14th September to the following bank account:

2.4. Late entries will be accepted under the approval of the Organising Authority.

## 3. Entry fee

70 €/person by bank transfer until 14th September, 80 €/person by paying at the registration in cash.

- 4.1. Scheduled number of races: 9
- 4.2. There can be maximum 4 races per day.
- 4.3. On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 15.00.

#### 5. Measurement







- 5.1. During the time of registration, all the crew members has to be present for weighing.
- 5.2. There will be no possibilities for measurements of new sails.
- 5.3. Boats has to comply with rule 78.1 from 2025 September 18. 9.30.

## 6. Sailing instructions

Sailing instructions will be available during registration, on the official notice board, on the official website of the event: www.thesail.hu.

#### 7. Venue

- 7.1. The harbour of the event is Tihanyi Hajós Egylet, 8237 Tihany, Kenderföld utca 19.
- 7.2. Courses will be on the eastern or on the western side of Tihany, which will be signalled by the RC upon leaving the shore.

#### 8. Scoring

- 8.1. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 8.2. When from 5 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 8.3. When 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

## 9. Berthing

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the harbour.

## 10. Haul-out restrictions

All boat shall be floating by 18th July 10:00 and shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee. [DP]

## 11. Diving equipment and plastic pools

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around boat between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta. [DP]

## 12. Radio communication

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

## 13. Media Rights

By participating on the Asso Hungarian Championship, the competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation. This includes footage made by a drone at any time during the regatta. Any action by the drone can not be ground for redress. Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment and positioning equipment as specified by the Organising Authority.

## 14. Prizing







- 14.1. Top three boats of the Hungarian Championship will be awarded by prizes.
- 14.2. The hungarian winner of the first race will be the winner of the Tóth László memorial prize.
- 14.3. The best boat who has at least 3 U26 crews entered wins the Rooster youth cup.

## 15. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 16. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 10.000.000 HUF per incident or the equivalent
